HOLIDAY GIVING PROGRAMS 2021

ADOPT-A-FAMILY

Interfaith Family Services provides holiday gifts to families through our Adopt-A-Family program. Beginning in October, families are interviewed and asked to provide one \$50 gift idea for each child. Our program also furnishes each family with a board game and a \$50 gift card so they may buy something special for their family. We also ask that you include gift wrapping supplies. We will have both small and large families available for adoption!

The total cost of adopting a family with one child is approximately \$125 with an additional \$50 cost for each additional child in the family.

HOLIDAY TOY DRIVE

Interfaith's Holiday Toy Drive is a program in which the community comes together to donate new toys and gift cards for children and teens. These gifts are collected and then distributed by appointment at the South County Community Center. This is a wonderful opportunity for families in need to ensure that their children will receive gifts this holiday season.

GIFTS FOR SENIORS

Interfaith Senior Services provides holiday gifts for senior adults, 62 and older, through the Gifts for Seniors Program. Beginning in September, seniors are asked to provide Interfaith with their \$50 gift card request. These gifts are then delivered to our senior residents during the holiday season.

FOOD ASSISTANCE

Each family receiving Holiday assistance is given food pantry staples, holiday foods and a grocery store gift card to prepare a traditional Holiday Meal with our Food Pantry Assistance.
