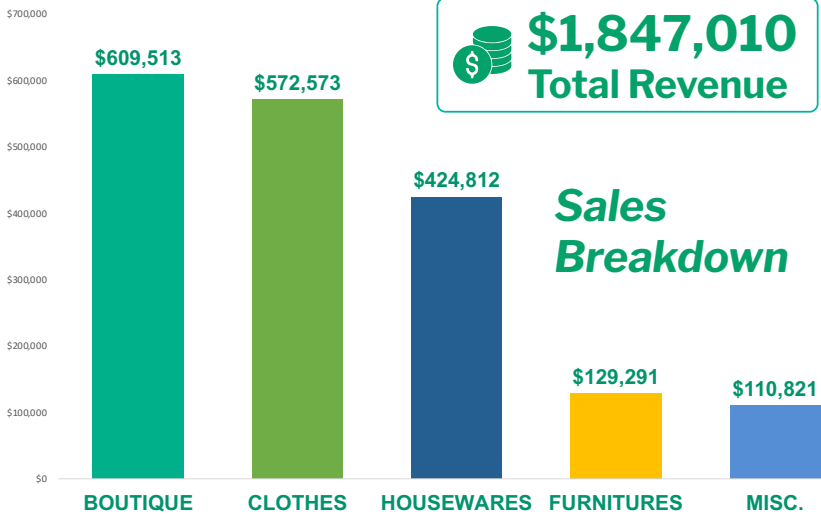

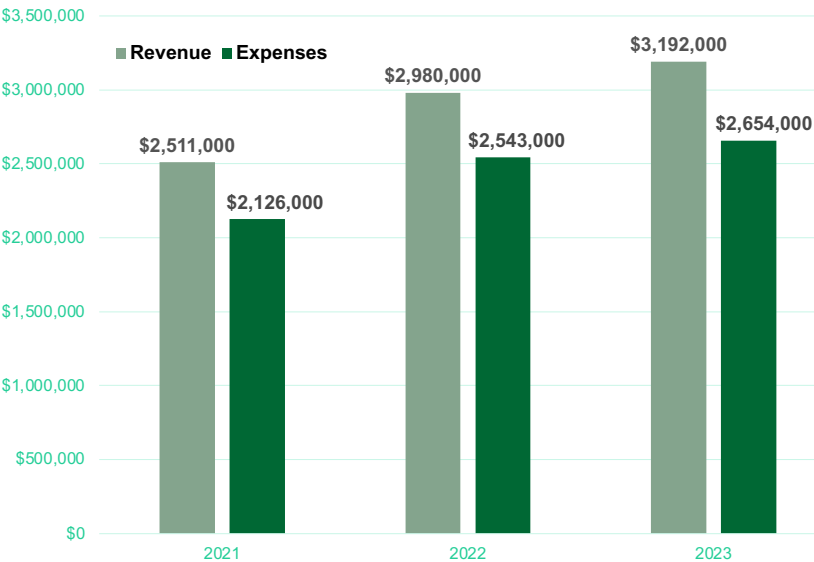
ICDC Registration 2023 - 2024 School Year

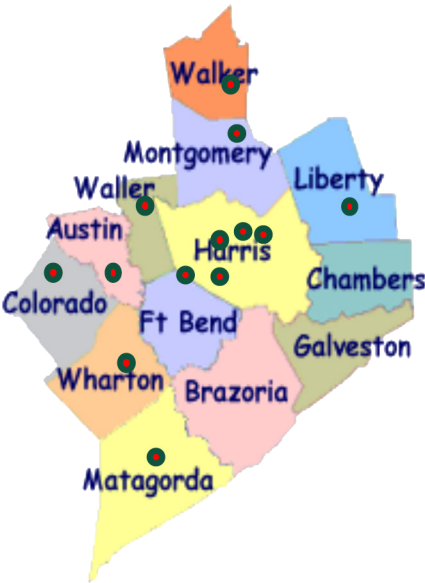

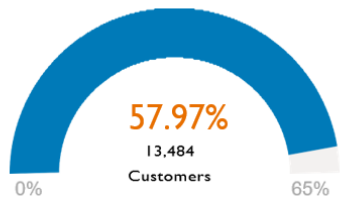

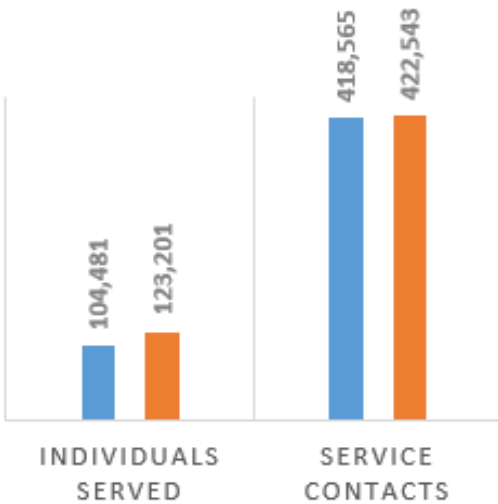
