# HURRICANE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS



#### Atlantic Hurricane Season

June 1 – November 30, peak is August and September

Montgomery County is a pass-through county, not an evacuation county. We most often see flooding and/or wind damage in South Montgomery County.

Additionally, families may be impacted by power outages, and loss of income due to effects of the storm.

### Be Prepared!

- Make a plan: know before the storm how you and your family will react
- Build a kit: have supplies assembled and gathered before a disaster strikes
- Stay informed: stay up-to-date with the latest news and accurate information.

#### Recommended supplies to include in a Basic Kit:

- Water
- Non-perishable Food
- · Manual can opener
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio
- Flashlight & batteries
- First Aid kit
- · Whistle to signal for help
- Filter mask
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities

- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- Items for unique family needs, such as daily prescription medications, infant formula or diapers
- · Important family documents.
